JD Group Corporate Timeline 1986 – 2007

- 1986 Mechanical Engineer Gino Tsai establishes JD Components Co., Ltd. as a manufacturer of aluminum bicycle components.

- 1989 JD extends factory capacity and adds high-tech laser equipment for production.

 Initiates aluminum welding production.

- 1990 JD starts cooperation with GT Bicycles USA, producing a variety of bike parts and accessories.

- 1992 JD launches TranzX brand for bicycle components and successfully markets brand globally.

- 1993 JD invests in China, beginning construction of JD Metal Industry Co., Ltd. in Shenzhen, China.

- 1996 JD Metal Industry Co., Ltd. starts production, manufacturing sporting goods and bike parts.

 Receives ISO 9002 quality system certification.

- 1997 JD commences research and development of environmentally friendly electric mobility.

- 1998 Expanding its presence in Europe, JD achieves European CE (Conformité Européenne) certification.

 JD launches CityBug brand for a new line of electric scooters.

 At the National Sporting Goods Association World Sports Expo in Chicago, Gino Tsai unveils the world's first aluminum Razor scooter launching a global fad.

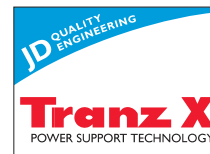
- 1999 JD is awarded Taiwan's prestigious Rising Star Award for outstanding business performance and making a significant contribution to Taiwan's national economy.

 Receives UL (Underwriters Laboratories) certification for compliance with rigorous industry US safety standards.

- 2000 Receives ISO 9001 certification for quality management system.

 JD starts cooperation with Razor USA and JD Japan.

 In the United States, JDs sleek, fold-and-carry Razor scooter, becomes the hottest selling product of the 2000 holiday shopping season selling millions of scooters within a year of their debut.



- 2001 JD introduces JD Bug brand for trendy mobility products and youth products.
- BusinessWeek names Gino Tsai as one of the top entrepreneurs of the year and includes him among the world's Top 25 managers of 2000.
- 2003 JD opens Melton Industrial Co., Ltd. in Dongguan, China - its second factory in southern China - to further expand manufacturing capacity.
- Starts new brand called JD Bike.
- 2004 JD becomes an OEM supplier for The Coca-Cola Company producing the CC Cruiser, a unique mobile form of product delivery at events.
- Begins relationship with Red Bull, manufacturing a series of aluminum displays and promotional accessories.
- 2005 Forbes magazine votes JDs kick scooter one of the 10 most popular toys of the last 100 years and the most popular toy of the decade.
- JD becomes an OEM supplier for Pride Mobility Scooters.
- JD produces electric scooters and go-karts for Ferrari.
- JD manufactures go-karts and kids' training bikes for Kawasaki.
- JD Melton Industrial Co., Ltd. achieves ISO 9001 certification.
- Initiates ambitious plans for new technology drive system and electric bike.
- 2006 JD begins development of a flat panel wall mount for flat-screen TVs.
- 2007 JD launches TranzX Power Support Technology at the 20th Taipei International Cycle Show.
